

Lee's Summit High School Theatre Parents Scholarships

Lee's Summit High School Theatre Parents Organization is dedicated to giving LSHS students an opportunity to further their educational interests in the area of theatre arts. We believe that our commitment to the development of talent in our youth will help foster the growth of the arts as a whole in our community. For the 2019-20 school year, LSHS Theatre Parents Organization is pleased to offer two scholarships:

- Scholarship 1 - a \$1,000 scholarship to a high school senior who has shown considerable involvement and dedication to the theatre department and will be majoring in Theatre at an accredited university or theatre arts school
- Scholarships 2 – a \$500 scholarship to a senior who has been actively involved and has shown dedication to the theatre department at LSHS

Each scholarship will be paid to the college of the winning student's choice their freshman year, not to exceed the cost of tuition and fees.

REQUIREMENTS:

- **Be a full-time senior attending LSHS**
- **Have a grade point average of 2.75 (not weighted) or higher**
- **Demonstrate involvement to theatre arts during your high school career**
- **Be an active Tiger Act member in good standing**
- **Intent to pursue a post-high school education**
- **Scholarship 1 – Apply only if you are planning on majoring in Theatre at an accredited university or theatre arts school**
- **Scholarships 2 – Any senior involved in the high school theatre department regardless of intended major may apply**

HOW TO APPLY – Please include the following:

- **Completed application – including essay**
- **High school transcript (*will be attached after application is submitted*)**
- **Two letters of recommendation from school faculty**
- **Return completed application with all attachments to the LSHS Guidance Department by *April 1, 2020* deadline.**

Scholarship winners will be announced during the Theatre Awards on May 14, 2020.

The judgment of the scholarship selection committee is final. In the event that the scholarship selection committee finds no suitable applicant for that school year, funds will be returned to the organization's treasury.
